Dorothy was born in the Dunlo, Pennsylvania area, just outside of Johnstown. Her dad was a coal miner and her mother a homemaker. They were also farmers, as were most folks in the area. She is one of 11 daughters and sits about middle of the pack. She said there were so many of them that they had to share not only a room, but also their beds. They slept “head to toe” with one another! Her one sister, Ann, enlisted in the military. She was, unfortunately, killed in an accident while on duty at her base. Dorothy was the first daughter in her family to graduate from High School which was quite an accomplishment for the time!

After completing high school, she moved to Cleveland for better job opportunities. She did find work at John’s Uptown Candy Kitchen & Nut Shop on Public Square. She had other jobs outside the home through the years. She worked at a factory named Leece Neville. She started on the assembly line and working up to a Line Foreman.

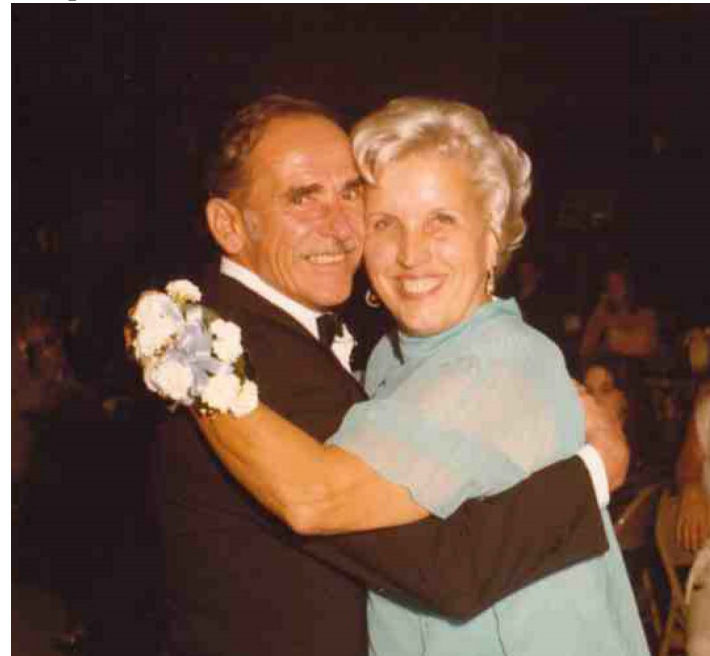
Later in life, she obtained her Real Estate license and worked for Smythe-Cramer in Brecksville, Ohio. One of her proudest moments was her McDonald’s deal where she worked long and hard to convince the town to allow the sale of a building to McDonald’s which would be the first fast food franchise in the town of Brecksville. Dorothy met her husband, Louis Zajc, in the mid 1940’s. They got married on the Fourth of July. They moved into an apartment above a bar in downtown Cleveland. After having their first two children, a son (Gary) and daughter (Gaile Ann), they needed more room and decided to leave the city and move to the suburbs. They bought their newly built house in Maple Hts., Ohio in January, 1957. They decided “new house, new baby”, and their third child, another girl (Karen Marie), was born the next year. Their fourth child, another girl (Renee Lavern), was born in 1962.

Dorothy has a passion and talent for decorating and enjoyed decorating their new home, especially for holidays. Christmas being her favorite. She enjoyed working in the yard, planting and landscaping, and having cookouts on the patio. One of her favorite pastimes was doing yard work. She would plant large bushes and trees, decide they didn’t look right, have them dug up again and replanted. Dig them up, move and plant, look at it, repeat. The record for a large bush was three moves!



She also remodeled and redecorated many times, long before it became popular on HGTV! She loved to move furniture to get a fresh look in the room and she continues this passion at Anna Maria as she decorates for the holidays and the seasons. She still moves furniture around in her apartment now!

Lou and Dorothy were together almost 50 years, until his passing in 1994. They enjoyed their home, their yard, their 4 children, 9 grandchildren and many great-grandchildren. They enjoyed many meals and celebrations around the dining table and on the back porch, as well as their many vacations! They visited beaches (one of her favorite spots!) in Florida and cruised to Acapulco where she LOVED bartering with the street vendors and got a great deal on a chess set! She also loved to have fun and “cut a rug” now and again... even dancing on the bar in a conga line in the Bahamas one time! They also traveled often to visit one of their daughters and son-in-law and granddaughters as they moved around the country, visiting Lexington, Cincinnati, Seattle, Portland, Boston, Virginia and North Carolina (they moved a lot) and another daughter in Roanoke.



When asked what is the secret to living to be 100?

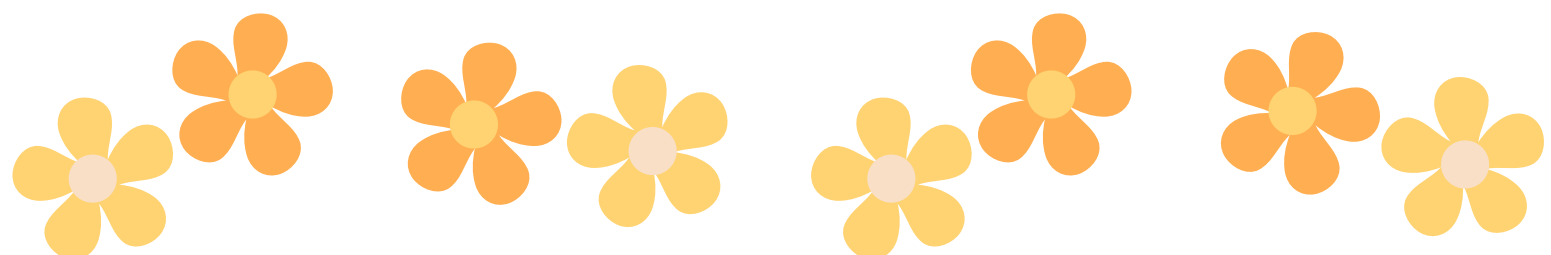
She said, “just let everything slide!”

“Have more fun and less work!”



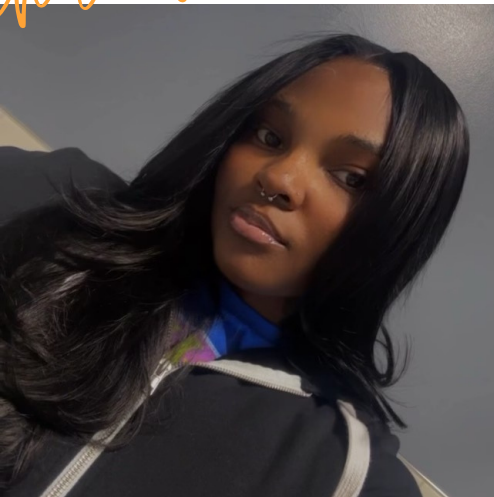

Mexican Chicken Soup

Ingredients

- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 onion , diced (brown, white, yellow)
- 1 red capsicum/bell pepper , large, diced
- 3 cloves garlic , minced
- 3 cups chicken broth/stock , low sodium
- 28 oz canned black beans, drained
- 28 oz canned corn, drained
- 28oz crushed canned tomato
- 1 lb chicken breast

SPICES

- 1 tbsp dried oregano
- 2 tsp cumin powder
- 2 tsp paprika powder
- 1 tsp each onion powder and garlic powder (or 2 tsp of one of them)
- 1 tsp cayenne pepper (optional, adjust spiciness)
- 1 tsp each salt + black pepper



Instructions

- Heat the oil over medium heat in a large skillet and sauté the onion, capsicum/bell pepper and garlic for 5 minutes until translucent.
- Add a splash of chicken broth, bring to simmer then tip it all into the slow cooker.
- Add remaining chicken broth, Spices, corn, bean and tomato. Give it a good stir, then add chicken and push down to submerge.
- Slow cook for 6 to 8 hours on LOW.
- Remove chicken onto plate, shred with 2 forks. Return into slow cooker, give it a good stir. Check if it needs more salt or pepper.
- Ladle into bowls and serve with Toppings of choice!

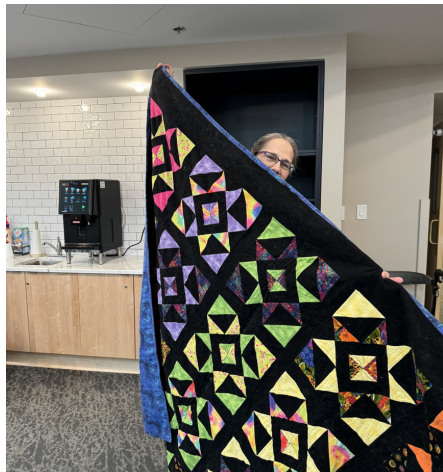

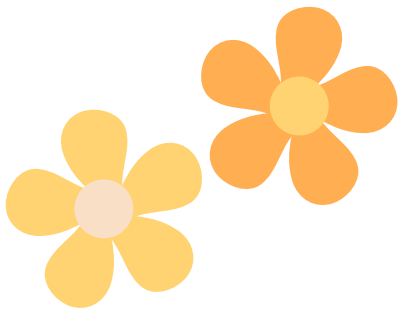

April 8, 2024- Total Solar Eclipse

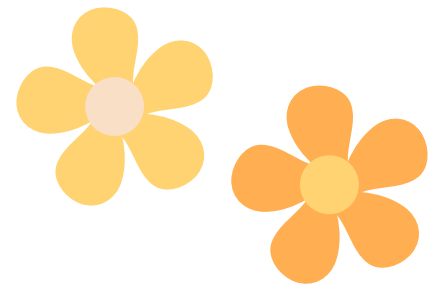
Get ready to witness the celestial show of a lifetime! Picture this: the Moon photobombing the Sun and Earth, throwing shade across our planet. If you find yourself in the Moon's shadow dance party (called the umbra), you're in for a total eclipse treat. But if you're in the semi-dark zone (the penumbra), you'll catch a partial eclipse peek. Remember, this cosmic spectacle only pops up during the New Moon phase. So mark your calendars and get your eclipse glasses ready for this rare cosmic event!



- This will be the first total solar eclipse in the continental U.S. in 7 years.
 - The last one occurred August 21, 2017. It crossed the country from Oregon to South Carolina, and millions of people viewed it successfully. Before that one, you have to go back to February 26, 1979. And it will be 20 years until the next one: August 23, 2044.
- A solar eclipse occurs when the Sun, the Moon, and Earth are aligned, or in syzygy.
 - The Moon, directly between the Sun and Earth, casts a shadow on our planet. If you're in the dark part of that shadow (the umbra), you'll see a total eclipse. If you're in the light part (the penumbra), you'll see a partial eclipse.
- A solar eclipse only happens at New Moon.
 - The Moon has to be between the Sun and Earth for a solar eclipse to occur. The only lunar phase when that happens is New Moon.
