### **CHARLES (CHUCK) BARBER**









Charles (Chuck) Barber was born on May 11th, 1930, in Grand River, Ohio, just a few blocks away from where the Shula family lived (the great Don Shula – NFL football player and former head coach of the Miami Dolphins). Chuck was the youngest of the four Barber children. When he was one, the family moved to a farm in Mentor, on Hendricks Road, where the family lived for many happy years. At Mentor High School, Chuck was quite the active student. He was the quarterback of the football team, excelled at track and field (pole vault, shotput, and discus), sang bass and tenor in the choir, and was president of student council. Wow! Quite the popular kid! He graduated in 1948 and enrolled at Ohio Wesleyan University, majoring in business administration and accounting. Just like in high school, Chuck remained active during his college years, playing basketball, football, track and field, and enjoyed the "Greek Life" with the Phi Gamma Delta fraternity, where he was, of course, president. As busy as college life was, he did find time to work at a men's clothing store on campus, Black Burns.

The photographer for the football team hung up some pictures of the football team one day in his shop, and a lovely young girl named Carolyn and her mother were going for a walk, passed the shop, and checked out the pictures. Carolyn pointed to one of the pictures with Chuck and said to her mother, "I'm going to marry that guy." As fate would have it, Chuck was friends with Carolyn's younger sister, Nancy, who later introduced the two. After graduation, Chuck joined the Air Force and served two years of active duty in Texas, Oklahoma, and Colorado, then four years of reserve duty. During this time, Chuck proposed to Carolyn, and she said YES!

They planned for a November wedding. Shortly after the proposal, Chuck decided that he really enjoyed his time serving in the Air Force and wanted to make a career out of it – obtain his wings and keep moving up the ranks. Though Carolyn respected his decision, she said she could not marry him. Chuck chose the love of his life over a military career and never turned back. The two married in November of 1954 as planned.

Having business degree, Chuck began a lucrative career in the sales division of a life insurance company, selling life and health insurance, retirement programs, etc. to corporations. He eventually became head of Human Resources at the corporate office in Hudson.

Chuck and Carolyn were blessed with a lovely family. Cheryl was born in 1956, and a few years later came along Elizabeth (Beth), followed by Charles Jr., aka Chip. All the kids were outstanding students and athletes; Chip, like his father, was quarterback of his high school football team.

Chuck has resided at Anna Maria for almost a year now, and he is quite happy. He has nothing but good things to say about the staff (they are the best, he says, as is our food). He remains as active as he can, and enjoys a nice lunch out with his many friends. A quote for the younger generation? "Have a firm foundation and belief in a higher power, trusting in God and that Jesus is your Lord and Savior – Your life will be completely different from what it was before" We are blessed to have Chuck Barber here with us, and we wish him continued good health and happiness.


Kensington residents assisted the activities staff with painting cardboard cutouts of presents. It's the most wonderful time of the year, and residents really enjoy helping!

### From the Holiday Kitchen of Sally Baltes

### RN, Director of Nursing

### **Ingredients**

4-6 cloves garlic

1 ½ cups fresh basil leaves, packed

1/3 cup walnuts or pine nuts

2 T. extra virgin olive oil

1 t. fresh lemon juice

3 – 8 oz. packages cream cheese, softened

1/3 cup freshly grated parmesan cheese

1 1/3 cups sundried tomatoes packed in oil,

drained

1/3 cup tomato paste

1/2 cup butter, softened

Kosher salt to taste

Freshly ground black pepper to taste

Pita Chips



#### **Directions:**

Finely chop garlic cloves in food processor; add basil, nuts, oil, and lemon juice. Process until well-blended. Add 1/3 cup cream cheeses, all parmesan cheese and pulses until just blended; place in a medium-sized bowl and set aside Coarsely chop tomatoes in food processor; add tomato paste and blend until mixture is almost smooth; add 1/3 cup cream cheese and blend well; transfer to a small bowl and set aside In a large bowl, mix remaining cream cheese and butter until fluffy, season with salt and pepper

Spray a 9" springform pan with non-stick spray and line with plastic wrap, allowing to drape over the sides

Using a spoon dipped in hot water, spread 3/4 of cream cheese/butter mixture evenly on bottom of pan – top with half of the tomato mixture, then 1/2 cup of cream cheese/butter mixture, then pesto mixture

Repeat layers, topping with cream cheese mixture. Cover and chill 6 hours or overnight Invert torta onto serving platter, carefully peel away plastic wrap, and serve with pita chips

**December 21** — Winter solstice! The first day of winter officially begins! Don't worry, spring is right around the corner!





From Thanksgiving to New Year's Day, household waste increases by more than 25%, with the majority being wrapping paper and packaging


