
Annual Campus of Anna Maria Chili Cook-Off





CHILI COOK-OFF - RECIPES

Unicorn's Last Supper Chili (White Chicken Chili)

2 – boneless chicken breasts
1 – 11 oz can of corn, drained
1 – 15 oz. can black beans, drained and rinsed
1 – 10 oz. can diced tomatoes with green chilies, undrained
2 cups chicken broth
1 cup cooked, chopped bacon (optional – Colleen did not use bacon)
1 – 1 oz. packet Hidden Valley Ranch Original Seasoning & Salad Mix
1 tsp. cumin
1 T. chili powder
1 tsp. onion powder
1 – 4 oz. cream cheese
1 cup shredded cheddar cheese

*** *Place chicken at bottom of a slow cooker. Add all ingredients (except cream cheese and cheddar cheese). Stir completely and place cream cheese on top. Cover and cook on LOW for 6-8 hours. Remove chicken and shred with fork. Return to slow cooker, and add cheddar cheese. Enjoy!

Physically Moving Chili (Black Bean and Beef Chili)

1 T. vegetable oil
1 lb. ground beef
1 T. olive oil
5 – cloves of garlic, chopped
1 each – onion, carrot, celery stalk, chopped
1 T. + 1 tsp. cumin
1 T. paprika
1 T. Italian seasoning
3 T. chili powder
28 oz. can fire roasted crushed tomatoes
1 cup – Beef Broth
1 – 15 oz. can black beans, drained and rinsed
Salt and pepper to taste

- 1). Heat vegetable oil, add ground beef and brown – Drain grease and set aside
- 2). Heat olive oil, add chopped onions, garlic, celery and carrots, saute about 5 minutes
- 3). Add cumin, paprika, chili powder, Italian seasoning to veggies, stir well and add cooked ground beef
- 4). Add canned tomatoes and beef broth, bring to a boil – cover and reduce heat to low, simmer for about one hour
- 5). After one hour, add black beans and salt and pepper (to taste). Stir and continue cooking on low for about 20 minutes. Serve and enjoy!


Secret Ingredient Chili

½ lb. Bob Evans Sausage
½ lb. extra lean ground beef (92%)
1 – orange bell pepper, chopped
1 – small sweet onion, chopped
1 – 15 oz. can fire roasted diced tomatoes (Glen Muir brand is preferred)
1 – 14 oz. can light kidney beans, undrained
1 – 14 oz can of corn, undrained
1 packet of Durkee Original Chili Seasoning
Cinnamon to taste (just a sprinkle)
¼ bar Hershey Chocolate (** this is the secret ingredient)


- 1). Brown sausage and beef, drain and set aside
- 2). Saute onions and peppers until fragrant and soft; add beef and sausage
- 3). In a large pot, combine all ingredients and bring to a boil
- 4). Reduce heat; simmer for 10-15 minutes, stirring occasionally
- 5). Enjoy!


DINING OUT...


A Blessed Thanksgiving To All!
